2. Assist your child to arrive on time and remind him/her to be polite and respectful.
3. Worship with your child to help them connect what they learn in confirmation class to everyday life. Use the Taking Faith Home sheets as a resource to talk about faith at home, building a foundation of faith in your child's life.
